I am a pediatric interventional cardiologist and outcomes researcher at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia. I am the Assistant Chief of the Division of Cardiology and an Associate Professor of Medicine in the Perelman School of Medicine at the University of Pennsylvania. I have an avid interest in clinical research training and oversight in my roles as Director of the Cardiac Center Clinical Research Core at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia and as the Assistant Program Director for our Division's NHLBI/ T32 Pediatric Cardiology Research Training Program.

I have formal training in epidemiology, study design, and biostatistics through the Master of Science in Clinical Epidemiology degree program in the Center for Clinical Epidemiology and Biostatistics at the University of Pennsylvania. My own research focuses broadly on outcomes for children with various forms of congenital heart disease, using a variety of data sources, from single center to large administrative datasets. My work has been externally supported by a number of granting agencies. I currently serve as co-PI for our center's involvement in the NIH/NHLBI Pediatric Heart Network.
