Elizabeth Eby Halvorson, MD, MS, FAAP is Assistant Professor of Pediatrics, Section of Hospital Medicine at Wake Forest School of Medicine. She completed her undergraduate training at the University of California at Berkeley followed by medical school at Vanderbilt University School of Medicine. She completed residency and chief residency in pediatrics at Wake Forest Baptist Medical Center and stayed on as faculty. She also completed a masters degree in Clinical and Population Translational Science through Wake Forest University. Her research focuses on the impact of pediatric obesity on care provided in the inpatient setting. She has explored this topic from a number of angles, including clinical outcomes of patients with obesity, adverse events occurring in the hospital, and weight bias exhibited by pediatric inpatient providers. She is involved in the Academic Pediatric Association's Research Scholars Program, first as a scholar and now as faculty.
