## Leyenaar, JoAnna

JoAnna Leyenaar, MD, MPH, MSc, is Associate Professor of Pediatrics and of The Dartmouth Institute for Health Policy & Clinical Practice at Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center, Lebanon, NH. In her clinical work she practices pediatric hospital medicine, with a special interest in care for children with social and medical complexity. Her research aims to improve the quality of healthcare provided to children, with current projects focused on the safety and effectiveness of direct admission to hospital admission for children, improving hospital-to-home transitions, and quality of care at community hospitals. Dr. Leyenaar completed medical school at McMaster University, public health training at Harvard University, and a master's degree in clinical research at Tufts University. She is current recipient of a K08 Mentored Career Development Award from the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality, co-chair of Region 1 of the Academic Pediatric Association, and a small group leader of the Academic Pediatric Association's Research Scholar's Program.
