Dr. Ryan is Associate Professor of Pediatrics and Assistant Dean for Clinical Medical Education at Virginia Commonwealth University School of Medicine/Children's Hospital of Richmond (VCU/CHoR) in Richmond, VA. Dr. Ryan completed medical school at Loyola University Chicago, Pediatrics residency at The University of Chicago, and received his Master of Education in Health Professions from Johns Hopkins University. He has held a number of educational leadership positions since joining VCU/CHoR in 2009. He previously served as the Pediatrics clerkship director from 2010-2013 and transitioned to the Dean's office in 2013 where he has been since. He led the reform of the clinical curriculum at VCU School of Medicine and currently serves as institutional team leader for the AAMC Core EPA pilot. Nationally, Dr. Ryan is heavily involved in activities for COMSEP, the APA, and the AAMC. He also serves as an adjunct faculty member for the MEHP program at Johns Hopkins where he teaches Curriculum Development and Educational Scholarship and is faculty for the APA/PHM APEX program. Dr. Ryan received the APA junior faculty teaching award in 2016. He has published 20 peer-reviewed publications on medical education topics including competency-based medical education, entrustable professional activities, and faculty/learner development. He was recently awarded an SGEA grant to study the transition between pre-clinical and clinical learning environments for medical students.
