Dr. Tapia is an attending physician at CHOP and an assistant professor of Pediatrics at the Perelman School of Medicine at the University of Pennsylvania. He is a graduate from the University of Concepcion (Chile) Medical School. He trained in General Pediatrics and Pediatric Pulmonology at CHOP, and is board certified in Pediatrics, Pediatric Pulmonology, and Sleep Medicine. He is funded by the National Institutes of Health to study the effects of hypercapnia on cerebral blood flow in children with obstructive sleep apnea. He has authored many original research papers and review papers on the complexities of the respiratory system during sleep and wakefulness. Dr. Tapia is also deputy editor of Paediatric Respiratory Reviews and reviews articles for other prestigious journals, such as the American Journal of Respiratory and Critical Care Medicine, the Annals of the American Thoracic Society, Pediatrics, Sleep, Pediatric Pulmonology, and the Journal of Clinical Sleep Medicine. Dr. Tapia is also the director of the fellowship in Pediatric Pulmonology. He is fluent in Spanish, French and English.
