

## **Yin, Larry**

Larry Yin, MD, MSPH is an Associate Professor of Clinical Pediatrics at the Keck School of Medicine of USC and Associate Professor of Occupational Science and Occupational Therapy in USC Mrs. T.H. Chan Division of Occupational Science and Occupational Therapy at the Herman Ostrow School of Dentistry of USC. He earned his BS from the University of California Riverside, MSPH from the University of California Los Angeles Fielding School of Public Health, MD from St. Louis University and completed his pediatric training and Chief Residency at Children's Hospital Los Angeles. He is American Board of Pediatrics certified in General Pediatrics and Developmental and Behavioral Pediatrics and is the Director of the USC University Center of Excellence in Developmental Disabilities and the Medical Director of the Boone Fetter Clinic at Children's Hospital Los Angeles. He currently serves on the AAP Executive Council on Children with Disabilities, the California State Council on Developmental Disabilities and is a member of the Disparities Task Force for the California Department of Developmental Services.

Dr. Yin's research has been informed by his clinical experiences and focuses on decreasing health disparities by improving access to high-quality healthcare and developmental screening and intervention for all children, especially children with developmental delay, disabilities or autism spectrum disorder. His other major area of interest has been in pediatric obesity prevention in underserved communities using population health strategies, intervention trials using technology to enhance behavior change at both the parent and child level, and creating inclusive models of group intervention.
