The Division of Adolescent Medicine has a history of outstanding clinical programs, innovative education and research, and advocacy. Our goal is to create a nationally-recognized adolescent research program that transforms adolescent health outcomes. Clinical programs include a hospital-based consultative service and outpatient practice focusing on all adolescent health issues including eating disorders, transition care, weight management, mental health disorders, substance use, transgender care, and sexual and reproductive health. Faculty also provide care at the city's juvenile detention centers.

The Director of Adolescent Research will serve as a leader for adolescent health research in the Division and conduct their own research.
