Dr. Billimoria is an Assistant Professor of Pediatrics at the University of Washington, attending neonatologist and Associate Medical Director of the Seattle Children's Neonatal Intensive Care Unit and Transport Team. She completed her pediatric residency from Wayne State University/Children's Hospital of Michigan and neonatology fellowship from Baylor College of Medicine/Texas Children's Hospital.

Her interests lie in neonatal outcomes research, studying the underlying causes of variations in the outcomes and health care utilization of neonates using clinical and administrative databases. She is currently collaborating with the State of Washington Department of Health to study the outcomes of newborns requiring resuscitation at birth and their survival at a year of age. She hopes to study the outcomes of preterm infants in the state of Washington, including their school age outcomes. Her other research interests lie in the use of telemedicine in regional neonatal consultations and to promote provider education on extracorporeal membrane oxygenation through telerounds. She also performs quality improvement projects in a level IV neonatal intensive care unit.
