Dawn Gano, MD MAS, is an Assistant Professor of Neurology and Pediatrics at the University of California, San Francisco. She obtained her undergraduate degree at McGill University, studied medicine at McMaster University, and completed residency in pediatric neurology at the University of British Columbia. She pursued fellowship training in neonatal neurology and clinical research methodology at UCSF. The focus of her research is the promotion of brain health in critically ill newborns with a particular emphasis on interventions to reduce brain injury and improve long-term neurodevelopmental outcomes in the preterm population. Dr. Gano is a faculty investigator in the UCSF California Preterm Birth Initiative, a transdisciplinary crosssector collaboration that aims to decrease the burden of prematurity. She serves as the UCSF Benioff Children's Hospital San Francisco site Principal Investigator of the Newborn Family Research Collaborative, and co-Investigator in the NIH-funded UCSF Baby Brain Research Group.
