Thomas Hooven, MD is an Assistant Professor in the Columbia University Department of Pediatrics, Division of Neonatal-Perinatal Medicine. He is a graduate of University of Michigan Medical School, and completed his general pediatrics residency and neonatology training at the Morgan Stanley Children's Hospital of Columbia/NewYork-Presbyterian. A former fellow in the Pediatric Scientist Development Program, Dr. Hooven's research interests center on maternofetal and neonatal bacterial infections, with an emphasis on genomic and bioinformatics approaches to understanding pathogenesis. He has also published widely on evaluation strategies for assessing newborns for sepsis. He has NIH funding for ongoing studies of group B *Streptococcus* colonization and infection.
