

## Russell, Christopher

Christopher J. Russell, M.D., M.S. is an academic pediatric hospitalist at Children's Hospital Los Angeles (CHLA) and an assistant professor at the Keck School of Medicine, University of Southern California (USC). He completed his undergraduate degree in Psychology and Biology at Harvard University, his medical degree at Harvard Medical School, his pediatric residency at the University of California, San Francisco campus and his master of science in Clinical, Biomedical & Translational Investigations from USC. His clinical responsibilities including attending on the pediatric inpatient service at CHLA. His research focuses on developing evidence-based care for hospitalized children with medical complexity, including acute respiratory infections such as pneumonia and bacterial tracheitis. His research efforts have been recognized through receipt of the USC Clinical and Translational Science Institute's KL2 Mentored Research Career Development Award (2014-16), the Academic Pediatric Association's Young Investigator Award (2015-16) and through the NIH Loan Repayment Program through the National Heart, Lung and Blood Institute (2017-present). Outside of his clinical and research responsibilities, Dr. Russell focuses on research mentorship of medical students, pediatric residents and pediatric hospital medicine fellows as well as improving representation of underrepresented in medicine throughout the continuum of physician training.
