Schondelmeyer, MD, MSc Dr. Schondelmeyer is an Assistant Professor of Pediatrics at the University of Cincinnati and an attending physician in Hospital Medicine at Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center. She completed her undergraduate and medical degrees at the University of Missouri, Columbia. She then went on to complete her pediatric residency and pediatric hospital medicine fellowship at Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center, completing a Master of Science in Clinical and Translational Research at the University of Cincinnati during her fellowship. Dr. Schondelmeyer's research focuses on using quantitative, qualitative, and implementation science methods to evaluate and reduce overuse of non-evidence based tests, treatments, and procedures for hospitalized children. She has been funded through institutional and foundation grants as well as the National Institutes of Health for her work addressing alarm fatigue and the overuse of continuous cardiorespiratory and pulse oximetry monitoring in children's hospitals.
