



### **Singh, Anne Marie**

Anne Marie Singh, MD, is an Associate Professor of Pediatrics in the Division of Allergy, Immunology and Rheumatology and Food Research Institute Affiliate at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. Dr. Singh joined to faculty at the UW after over 7 years at Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine after completing allergy-immunology fellowship and postdoctoral training at University of Wisconsin-Madison. She is recognized leader in food allergy and the development of atopic diseases in early life. Her research program is focused on how environmental and microbial exposures affect mechanisms of tolerance, including regulatory T cells. The goal of her work is to enhance the clinical care of atopic patients by both advancing clinical care and by understanding mechanisms of disease. Therefore, she performs translational studies as well as clinical studies to better understand food allergy, atopic dermatitis and early life wheezing.
