Dr. Jeanie B. Tryggestad is an assistant professor of pediatrics in the section of diabetes/endocrinology at the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center and holds the Paul and Ruth Jonas Chair in Diabetes/Endocrinology. She received her Bachelor of Science in Biology from Oklahoma Christian University. She completed her medical school education at the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center graduating with distinction.

Dr. Tryggestad completed her residency in pediatrics and fellowship in pediatric endocrinology at the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center as well. She is board certified in pediatrics as well as pediatric endocrinology. Dr. Tryggestad's research interest focus on the impact of maternal diabetes on the future cardiometabolic health of the offspring and the impact of obesity and diabetes on vascular function. She has recently been awarded a 4 year grant through the NIH to understand the impact of maternal diabetes on miRNA expression and protein regulation in infants. She is a CoPrinciple Investigator for the NIH funded TODAY trial and serves on the Comorbidity Assessment Committee.
