PPB seeks a candidate who has a strong background in pregnancy and perinatology, with additional expertise in clinical research, including large, multicenter clinical trials. Also desired: strong communication and leadership skills and in-depth knowledge of research in obstetrics, pediatrics, and neonatology—especially in maternal-fetal medicine and related fields.
