• Serve in a leadership role in program development, as the NICU Medical Director. Serve as a physician champion of neonatal services. This includes involvement as needed for normal newborn patient population, in collaboration with the newborn hospitalists.

This position will have clinical responsibilities including:

- As Medical Director, provide support and direction for facility needs for the neonatal program.
- Provide medical leadership in the development of clinical guidelines, protocols, policies, procedures, order sets, and information systems that support the delivery of neonatal care.
- Establish strong collaborative relationships with medical staff and other non-physician providers within the neonatal team.
- Provide inpatient clinical care related to the neonatal intensive care unit.
- Teach to a variety of learners, including medical students, residents and fellows. Teaching can occur within the classroom, small groups and lectures, as well as in the delivery of clinical care.
- The successful applicant will participate in administrative and committee work to support the clinical and scholarly missions of UW Health and the School of Medicine and Public Health. An essential part of these duties will be working in a collegial relationship with other faculty members.

Qualifications:

- MD/ DO or equivalent, eligible for a Wisconsin Medical License.
- Completion of US pediatric residency and relevant fellowship programs. Interest in academic medicine, involving teaching to a variety of learners is essential. Experience in an academic medical setting preferred.
- Required to be BC/BE in Pediatrics and BCP Board Certified in Pediatrics
